


## Example: Set Class Intentions

**Course:** Institutions in Time

**Level:** Undergraduate

### Set-Up

The intentions question was integrated into a 5-minute online quiz on the preparatory readings for each class. This quiz was given to students through MS Teams, and they were asked to fill it out right at the start of each class.
